Arasys Inch Loss System III --- Co-developed by one of the scientists behind the pacemaker and just approved by the FDA, this machine uses a galvanic current to break down cellulite. You wear a special belt with attached electrodes through which your nerve endings are zapped, causing muscles in the target area to contract involuntarily. When the 17-minute procedure is over, you feel as if you have just had a major workout.

One Bazaar staffer tried the Arasys machine and lost an inch around her hips after the first treatment. Her thighs stayed the same, but she reports they did feel tightened and toned, and her cellulite was less visible. Suzanne Levine, D.P.M. (212-535-0229), co-author of *You Don't Need Plastic Surgery: The Doctor's Guide to Youthful Looks with No Surgery, No Pains, No Downtime*, says even better, longer-lasting results can be achieved after three or four visits. (Ten weekly visits then monthly maintenance is recommended.) Price: About \$250 per session.
